

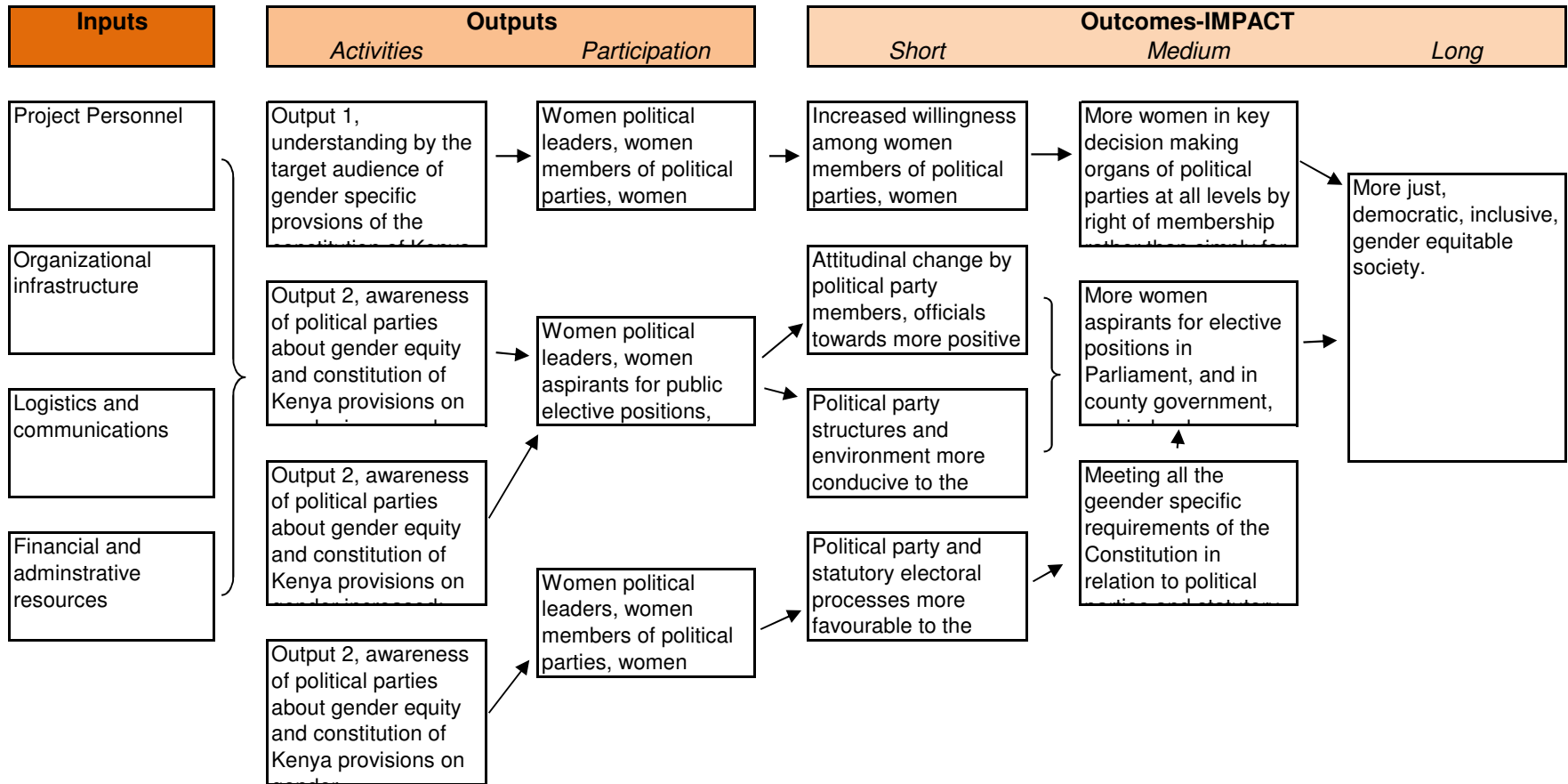

Brief Situation Description
 Kenyans are expected to go for the first General Election under the new constitutional dispensation on 4th March 2013. The Constitution requires that both men and women participate in leadership and specifically requires that not more than two thirds of either gender will occupy elective and appointive offices. There is a need for greater public awareness of these affirmative action principles and of gender rule as spelt out in the constitution, hence the need for sensitization and public education as well as targeted lobbying with primary institutions responsible for implementing the gender rule and of affirmative action, including political parties. This project seeks to contribute to the overall goal of increasing the number of women in elective and affirmative action positions through sensitization sessions for the general citizenry, political parties and of women in particular to
