- Kenyans overwhelmingly ushered our current constitution on the promise of Devolution and its associated access to resources to the grassroots.
- Article 10 of the Constitution of Kenya outlines public participation as one of the national values and principles of governance . **As such, all organs of both the national and county governments should put measures in place to ensure public participation in their activities.**
- On public finance management, Article 201 of the Constitution of Kenya provides for openness and accountability in public financial matters including public participation. Both national government and county governments are thus required to exercise responsible financial management and fiscal reporting.

- **To ascertain County residents' assessment on the performance of their County Governments against set Key performance indicators**
- To develop a County residents'/Citizens Scorecard on the performance of their County governments specifically in the areas of

 - Public finance management

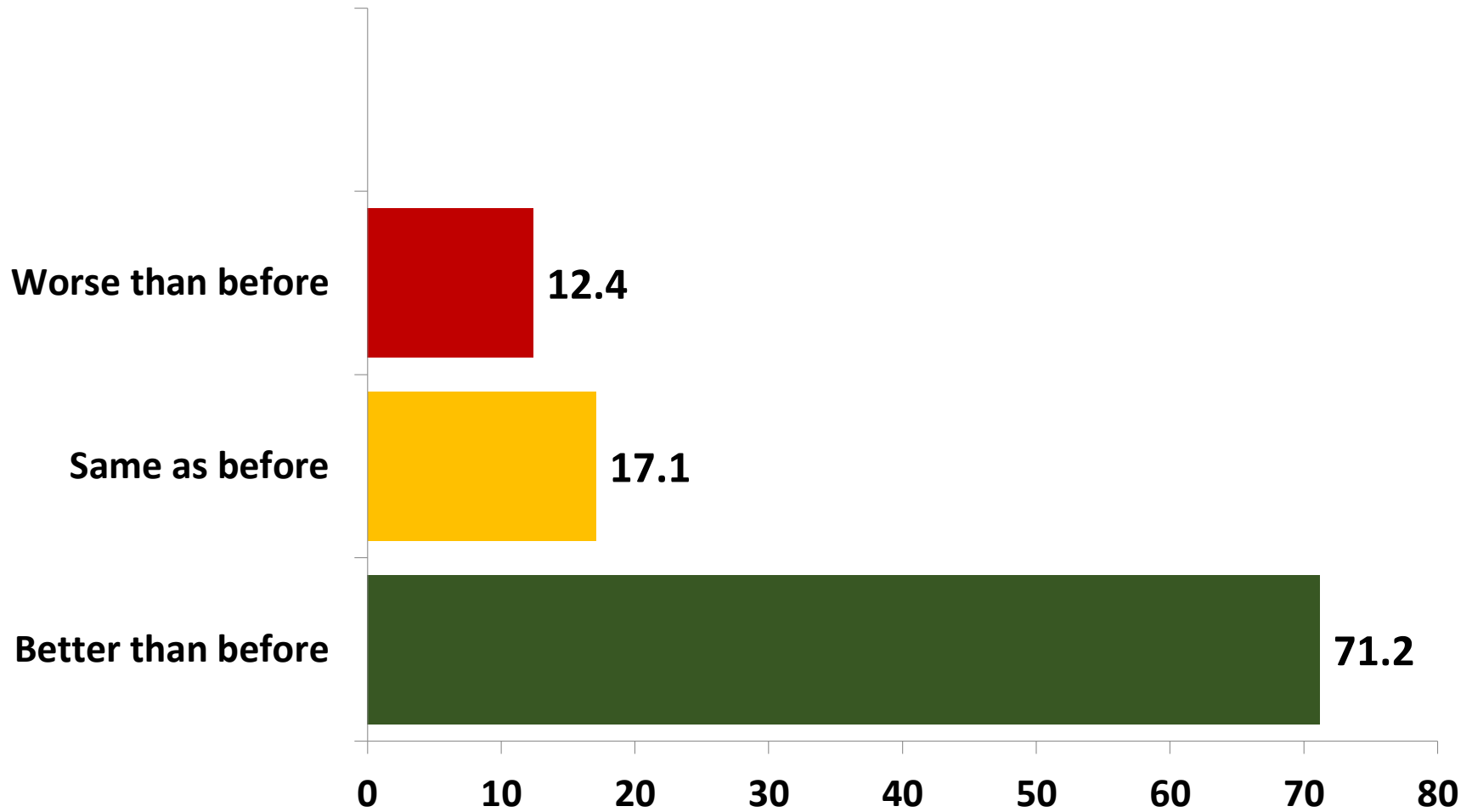

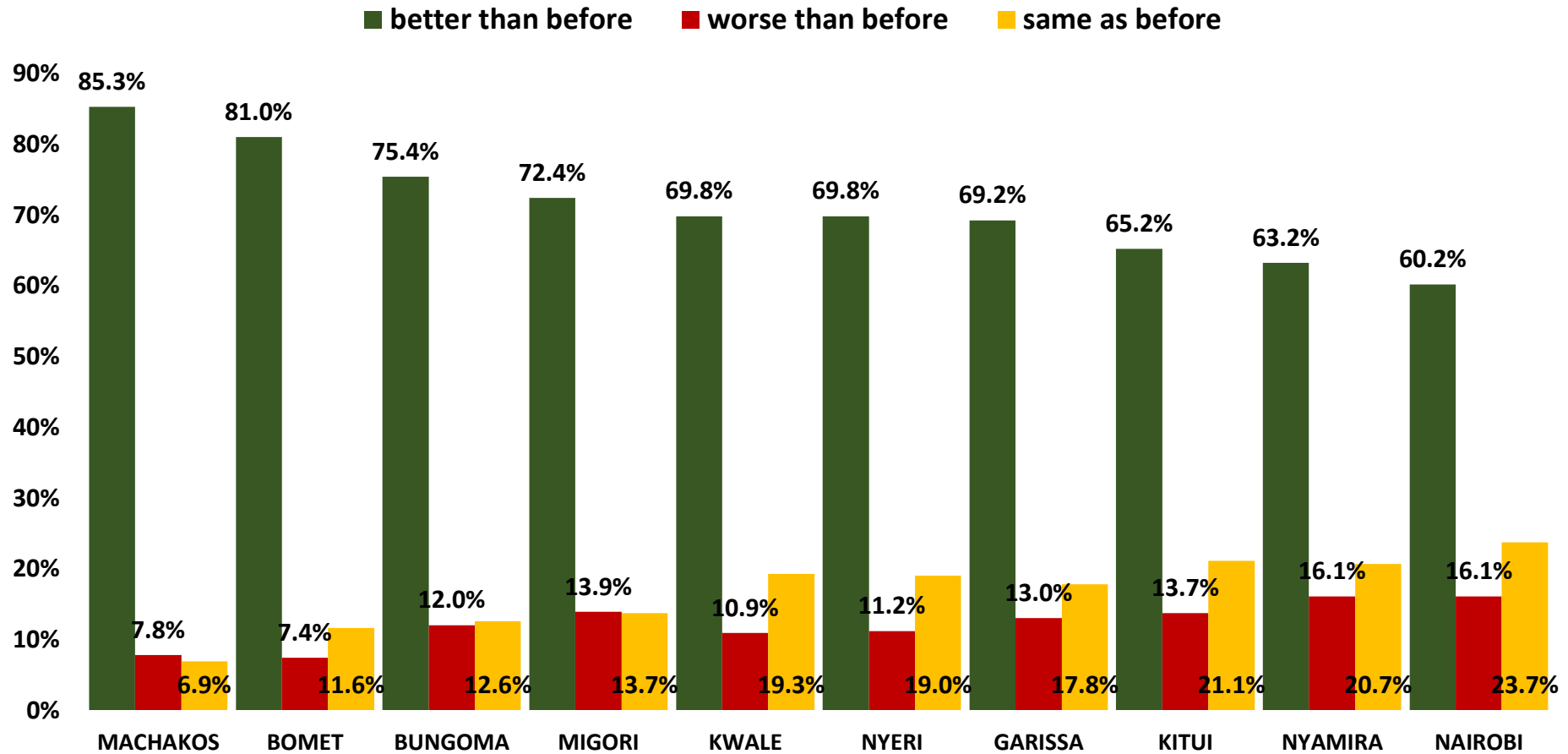
- **The poll was conducted between the months of March and April 2015;**
- **A sample of 600 respondents per county was interviewed translating into a margin of error +/- 4 at 95% degree of confidence.**
- **The survey covered 10 counties namely; Machakos, Bungoma, Nyamira, Nairobi, Bomet, Nyeri, Kwale, Garissa, Migori, and Kitui counties**
- **Using the 2009 census, the sample was designed using Population Proportionate to Size (PPS) and mainly entailed;**
 - **Use of stratification to ensure all Wards are covered**
 - **Ensuring further distribution by age and gender**
 - **Using the ward as the key administrative boundary**
 - **Ensuring that every adult in the county has a known chance of being selected**
- **Data was collected through Computer Assisted Telephone Interviews**
- **Data processing & analysis was done using SPSS**
- **The questions asked to the respondents are highlighted under each graphic presentation**

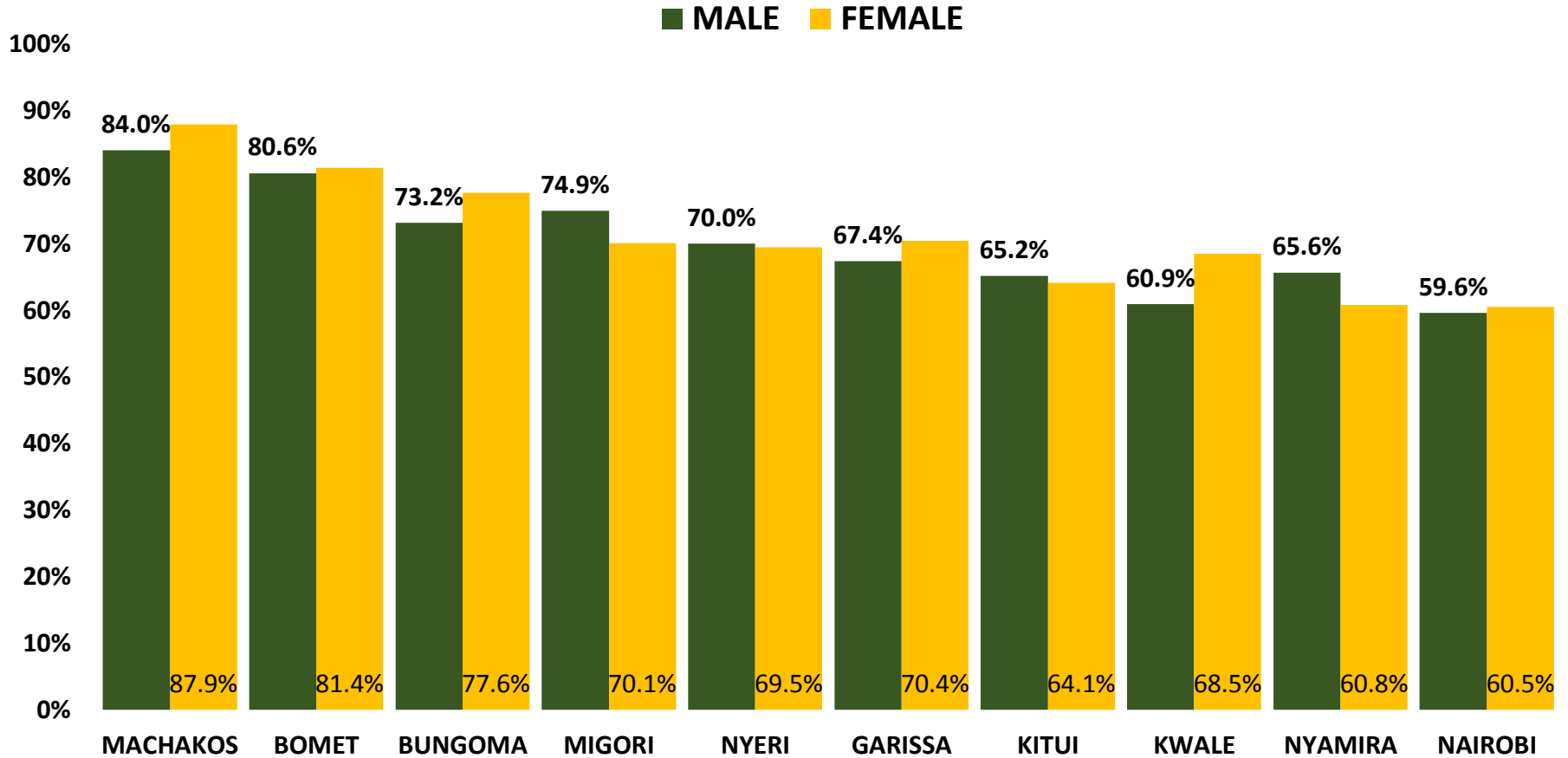

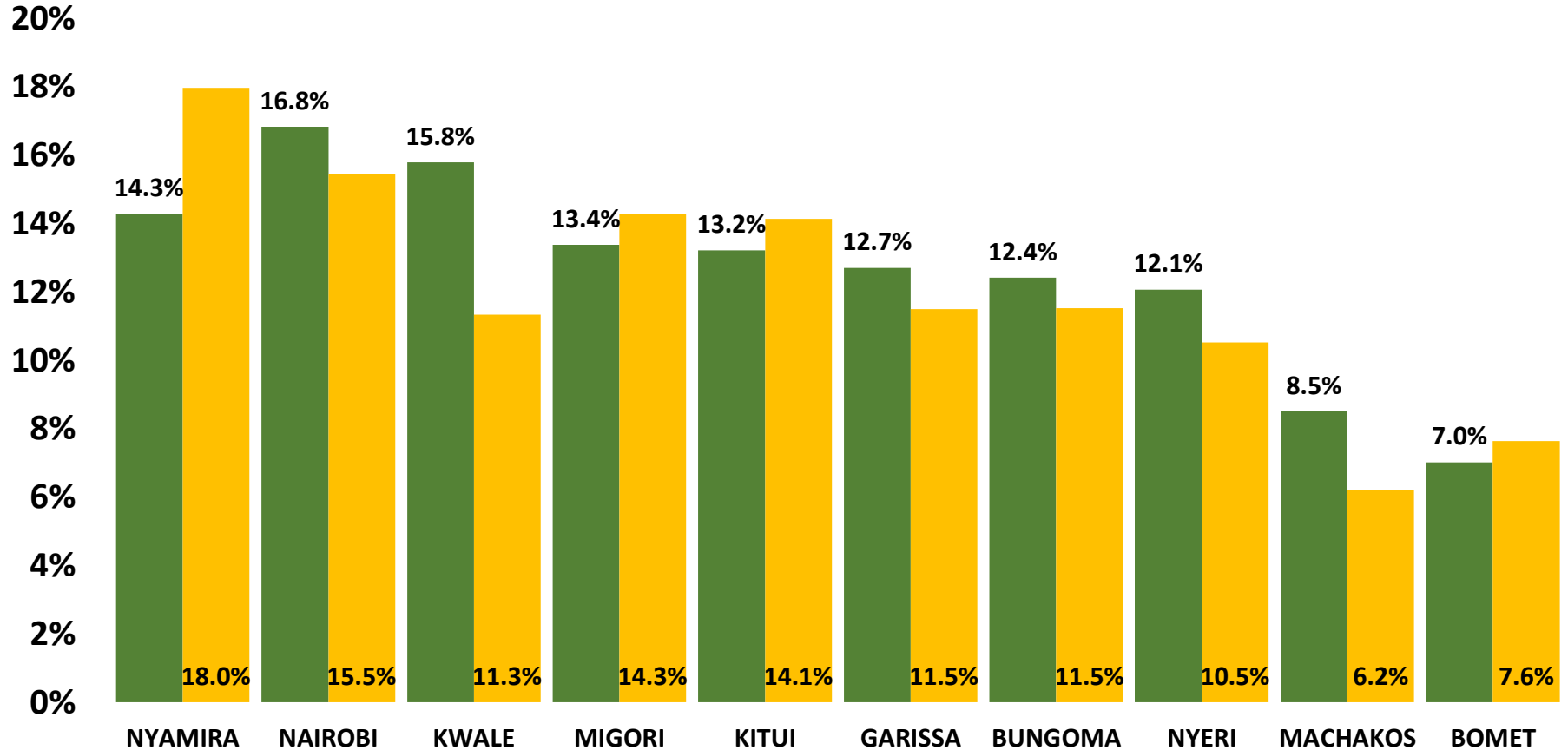

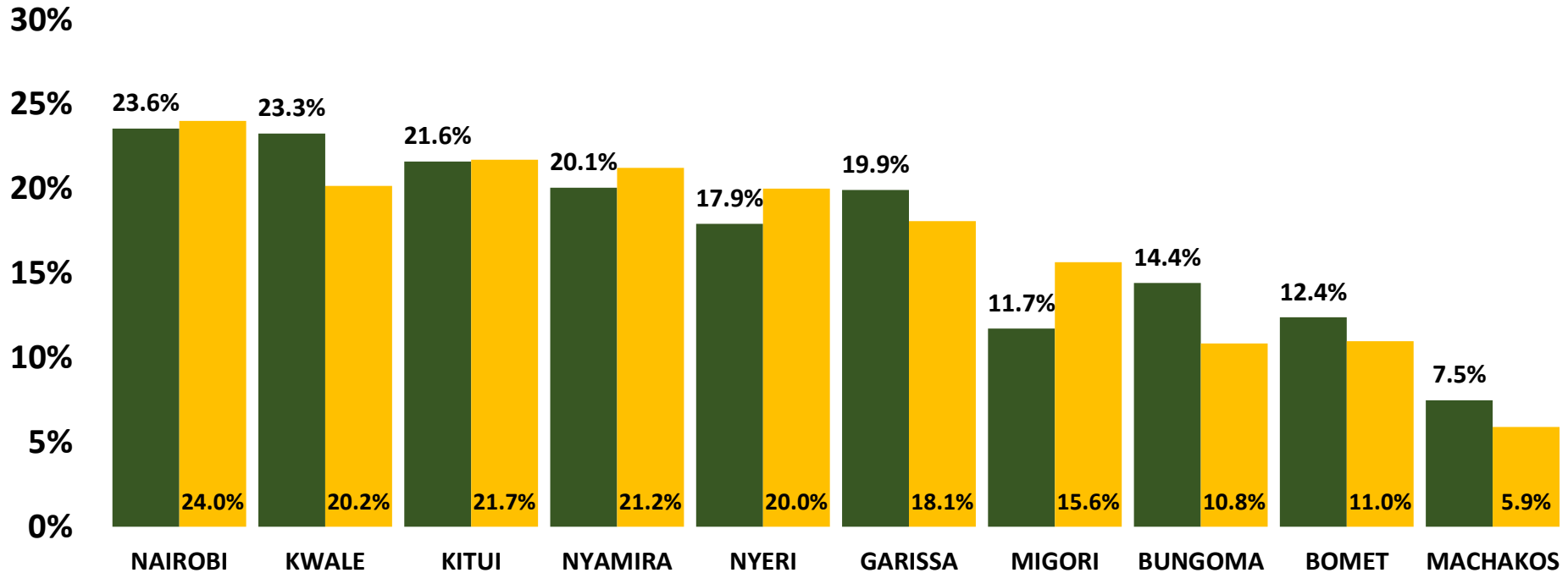

Has Devolution made a difference in your County? By Gender

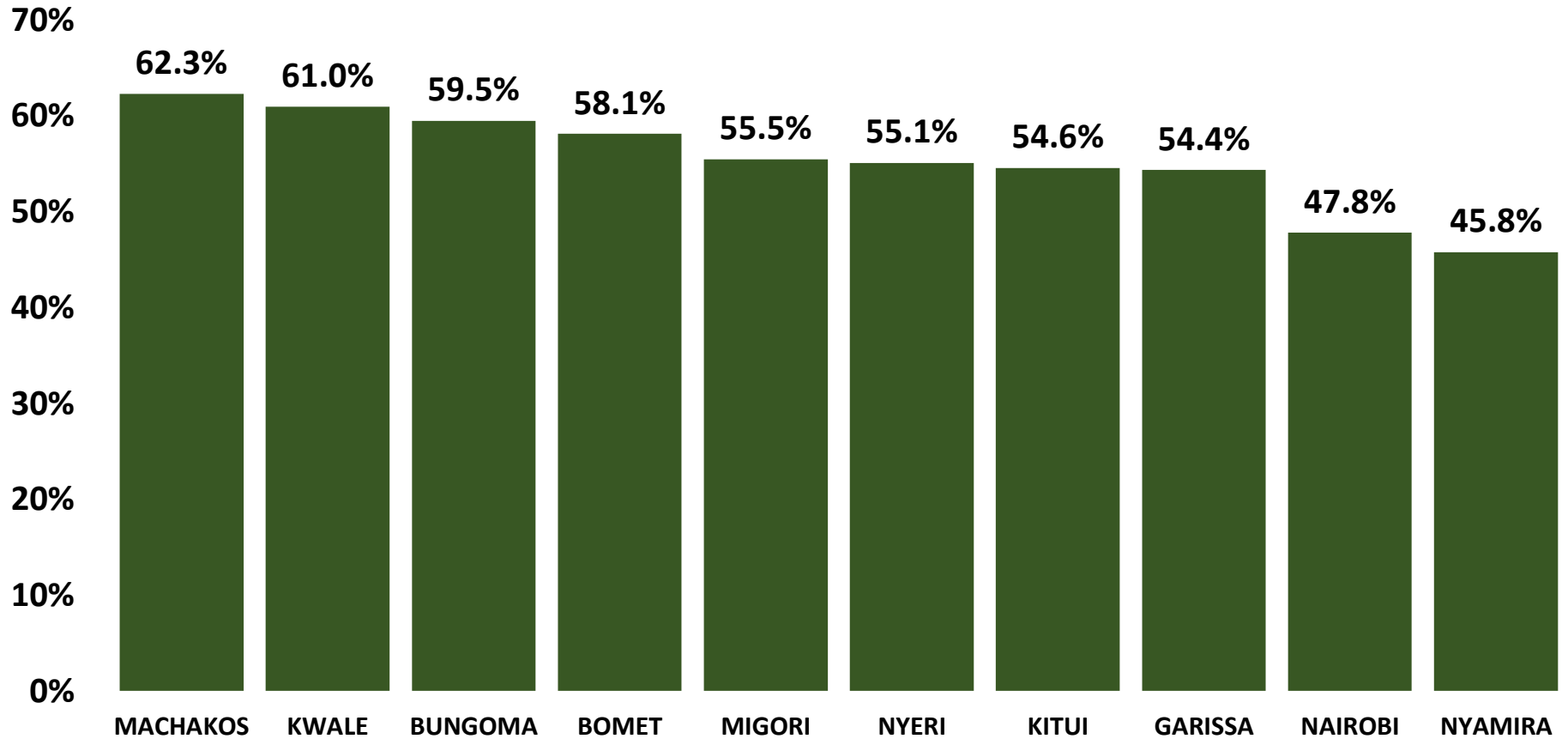

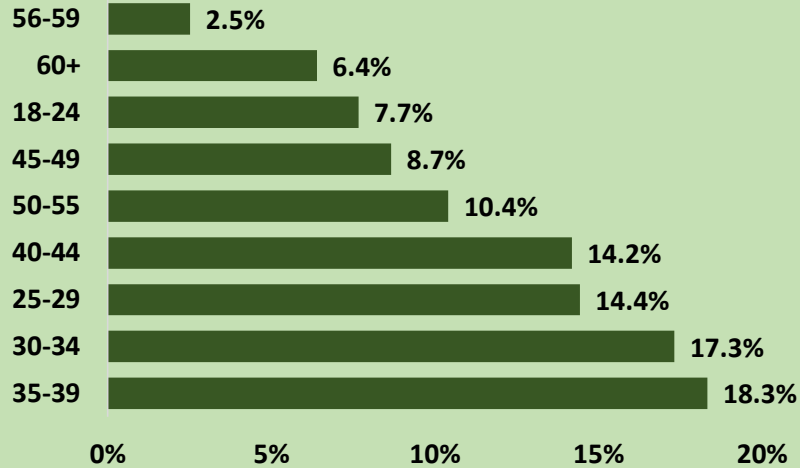

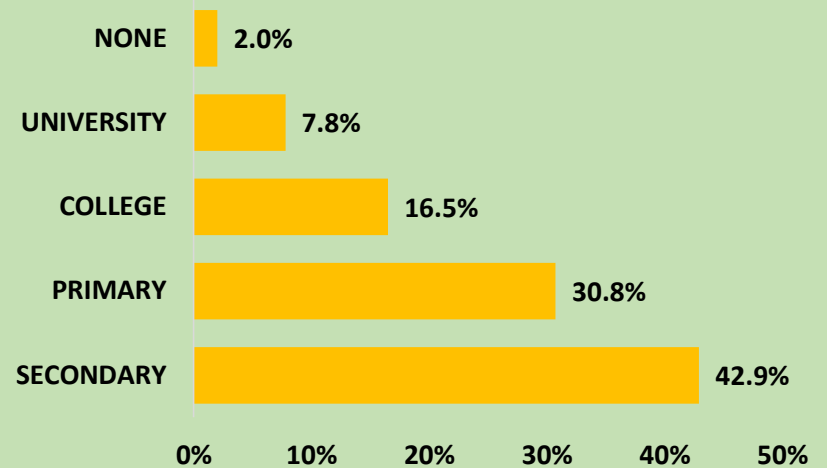
